9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 46.2-1090 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-1090. Warning devices on school buses; other buses; use thereof; penalties.
12	Every bus used for the principal purpose of transporting school children shall be equipped with a
13	warning device of such type as may be prescribed by the State Board of Education after consultation
14	with the Superintendent of State Police. Such a warning device shall indicate when such bus is either (i)
15	stopped or about to stop to take on or discharge children, the elderly, or mentally or physically
16 17	handicapped persons or , (ii) stopped or about to stop for another such bus, when approaching from any direction, that is stopped or shout to stop to take on or discharge any such persons, or (iii) when such that
17 18	direction, that is stopped or about to stop to take on or discharge any such persons, or (<i>iii</i>) whenever the bus door is opened. Such warning device shall be used and in operation for at least 100 feet before any
10 19	proposed stop of such bus if the lawful speed limit is less than thirty-five miles per hour, and for at
20	least 200 feet before any proposed stop of such bus if the lawful speed limit is thirty-five miles per hour
2 0 2 1	or more.
22	Failure of a warning device to function on any school bus shall not relieve any person operating a
23	motor vehicle from his duty to stop as provided in §§ 46.2-844 and 46.2-859.
24	Any person operating such bus who fails or refuses to equip such vehicle being driven by him with
25	such equipment, or who fails to use such warning devices in the operation of such vehicle shall be
26	guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.

27 Transit buses used to transport school children in the City of Hampton may be equipped with an
28 advisory sign that extends from the left side of the bus and displays the words:
29 "CAUTION-STUDENTS." Such sign may be equipped with not more than two warning lights of a type
30 approved for use by the Superintendent of State Police.
