10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 54.1-2410 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 54.1-2410. Definitions.
13	As used in this chapter or when referring to the Board of Health Professions regulatory authority
14	therefor, unless the context requires a different meaning:
15	"Board" means the Board of Health Professions.
16	"Community" means a city or a county.
17	"Demonstrated need" means (i) there is no facility in the community providing similar services and
18 19	(ii) alternative financing is not available for the facility, or (iii) such other conditions as may be established by Board regulation.
20	"Entity" means any person, partnership, firm, corporation, or other business, including assisted living
<b>20</b> <b>21</b>	facilities as defined in § 63.2-100, that delivers health services.
22	"Group practice" means two or more health care practitioners who are members of the same legally
23	organized partnership, professional corporation, not-for-profit corporation, faculty practice or similar
24	association in which (i) each member provides substantially the full range of services within his licensed
25	or certified scope of practice at the same location as the other members through the use of the
26	organization's office space, facilities, equipment, or personnel; (ii) payments for services received from a
27	member are treated as receipts of the organization; and (iii) the overhead expenses and income from the
28	practice are distributed according to methods previously determined by the members.
29 30	"Health services" means any procedures or services related to prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and care rendered by a health care worker, regardless of whether the worker is regulated by the
31	Commonwealth.
32	"Immediate family member" means the individual's spouse, child, child's spouse, stepchild, stepchild's
33	spouse, grandchild, grandchild's spouse, parent, stepparent, parent-in-law, or sibling.
34	"Investment interest" means the ownership or holding of an equity or debt security, including, but not
35	limited to, shares of stock in a corporation, interests or units of a partnership, bonds, debentures, notes,
36	or other equity or debt instruments, except investment interests in a hospital licensed pursuant to Article
37	1 (§ 32.1-123 et seq.) of Chapter 5 of Title 32.1.
38 39	"Investor" means an individual or entity directly or indirectly possessing a legal or beneficial
<b>40</b>	ownership interest, including an investment interest. "Office practice" means the facility or facilities same building at which a practitioner or another
41	practitioner in his group practice, on an ongoing basis, provides or supervises the provision of health
42	services to consumers. A practitioner will be considered, for purposes of this chapter, to satisfy any
43	standards for supervision if the practitioner or another practitioner in the practitioner's group practice
44	complies with all applicable Medicare payment and coverage rules for health services, or if the
45	practitioner, in his clinical judgment, considers himself to be supervising the provision of such health
46	services.
47 19	"Practitioner" means any individual certified or licensed by any of the health regulatory boards within the Department of Health Professions, except individuals regulated by the Board of European Directory
48 49	the Department of Health Professions, except individuals regulated by the Board of Funeral Directors and Embalmers or the Board of Veterinary Medicine.
49 50	"Referral" means to send or direct a patient for health services to another health care practitioner or
51	entity outside the referring practitioner's group practice or office practice or to establish a plan of care
52	which requires the provision of any health services outside the referring practitioner's group practice or
53	office practice.
54	"Same building" means a structure with, or a combination of structures that share, a single address
55	as assigned by the United States Postal Service.
