WHEREAS, among his many accolades over the course of a distinguished career, John Byers was honored as Citizen of the Year by the Mount Vernon Council of Citizens' Associations in 1995 and with the West Point Society of the District of Columbia Distinguished Member Award for his exemplary service to his alma mater and community in 1999; and

WHEREAS, John Byers has been a visionary leader, dedicated to the future of Fairfax County and improving the quality of life of all of the citizens of the Mount Vernon community; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend and congratulate John R.
