6 WHEREAS, Sacred Heart Catholic School in Danville was named a 2006 No Child Left Behind7 Blue Ribbon School by the United States Department of Education; and

8 WHEREAS, the No Child Left Behind Blue Ribbon Schools Program honors public and private K-12
 9 schools that are either academically superior in their states or that demonstrate dramatic gains in student
 10 achievement; and

11 WHEREAS, Sacred Heart scored in the top 10% on state assessment exams and ranked in the top 12 10% nationwide on standardized test scores in reading and math; and

WHEREAS, Sacred Heart was one of 10 schools in the Commonwealth and 250 schools across thecountry to be honored as a 2006 No Child Left Behind Blue Ribbon School; and

WHEREAS, Sacred Heart Catholic School was established in 1953 when four Sisters of Mercy from
 Merion, Pennsylvania, opened the school with just 67 students and today it has approximately 325
 students in preschool through grade nine; and
