§ 2.2-4310. Discrimination prohibited; participation of small, women-, minority- and special disabled

A. In the solicitation or awarding of contracts, no public body shall discriminate against a bidder or offeror because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, status as a special disabled veteran, or any other basis prohibited by state law relating to discrimination in employment. Whenever solicitations are made, each public body shall include businesses selected from a list made available by

of small businesses and businesses owned by women and, minorities, and special disabled veterans in procurement transactions. The programs established shall be in writing and shall comply with the provisions of any enhancement or remedial measures authorized by the Governor pursuant to subsection C or, where applicable, by the chief executive of a local governing body pursuant to § 15.2-965.1, and shall include specific plans to achieve any goals established therein. 3. "Hispanic American" means a person having origins in any of the Spanish-speaking peoples of

4. "Native American" means a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and who is regarded as such by the community of which this person claims to be a part or who is recognized by a tribal organization.

72 "Minority-owned business" means a business concern that is at least 51% owned by one or more 73 minority individuals or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company or other 74 entity, at least 51% of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited liability 75 company or other entity is owned by one or more minority individuals and both the management and 76 daily business operations are controlled by one or more minority individuals.

"Small business" means an independently owned and operated business which, together with affiliates, has 250 or fewer employees, or average annual gross receipts of \$10 million or less averaged over the previous three years.

80 "Special disabled veteran" means a veteran who served on active duty in the United States military
81 ground, naval, or air service and who was discharged or released from active duty because of a
82 service-connected disability.

"Special disabled veteran-business" means a business concern that is at least 51% owned by one or
more special disabled veterans or in the case of a corporation, partnership, or limited liability company
or other entity, at least 51% of the equity ownership interest in the corporation, partnership, or limited
liability company or other entity is owned by one or more individuals who are special disabled veterans
and both the management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more individuals who
