11	1. That § 18.2-59 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-59. Extorting money, etc., by threats.
13	If any Any person threaten who (i) threatens injury to the character, person, or property of another
14	person, or accuse (ii) accuses him of any offense, or threaten (iii) threatens to report him as being
15	illegally present in the United States, or (iv) confiscates, withholds or threatens to withhold any actual
16	or purported passport, immigration document, or other government identification document, and thereby
17	extort extorts money, property, or pecuniary benefit or any note, bond, or other evidence of debt from
18	him or any other person, he shall be is guilty of a Class 5 felony.
19	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
20	commitment Dursuent to \$ 30-10 1.1 the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
