- 2 3 4 5 6 A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 18.2-248.03, relating to 7 manufacturing, selling, giving, distributing of methamphetamine; penalty. 8
 - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-248.03 as follows:

10 § 18.2-248.03. Manufacturing, selling, giving, distributing, or possessing with intent to manufacture, 11 sell, give, or distribute methamphetamine; penalty.

12 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person who manufactures, sells, gives, distributes, or possesses with intent to manufacture, sell, give, or distribute 28 grams or more of a mixture or 13 substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers 14 is guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more than \$500,000 and imprisonment for not less than 15 five nor more than 40 years, three years of which shall be a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment 16 17 to be served consecutively with any other sentence.

18 B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person who manufactures, sells, gives, distributes, 19 or possesses with intent to manufacture, sell, give, or distribute 227 grams or more of a mixture or 20 substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers 21 is guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000,000 and imprisonment for not less 22 than five years nor more than life, five years of which shall be a mandatory minimum term of 23 imprisonment to be served consecutively with any other sentence.

2. That the provisions of the first enactment of this act shall not become effective unless an 24 appropriation of funds effectuating the purposes of this act is included in the general 25 appropriation act for the period of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008, and passed during the 26 2007 Session of the General Assembly and signed into law by the Governor. If such funds are 27 28 appropriated, then the provisions of this act shall become affective July 1, 2007.

29 3. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or 30 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$705,140 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be 31 32 determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.

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
