# 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

## 7 1. That § 17.1-266 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

**8** § 17.1-266. Services rendered in Commonwealth's cases.

9 No clerk, sheriff or other officer shall receive payment out of the state treasury for any services 10 rendered in cases of the Commonwealth, whether in a court of record or a court not of record, except as

allowed by statute. Localities shall be exempt from paying fees for services rendered by a clerk or other

12 court officer for cases, whether in a court of record or a court not of record, when the locality is a

13 party to a case commenced in a court serving that locality or in any other jurisdiction when the

14 localities have a reciprocal waiver of fees agreement. Sheriffs may, in writing, grant a waiver of the

15 sheriff's fee to one or more localities.
