That § 67-300 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 67-300. Offshore natural gas and wind resources. A. In recognition of the need for energy independence, it shall be the policy of the Commonwealth 11 to support federal efforts to determine the extent of natural gas resources 50 miles or more off the 12 Atlantic shoreline, including appropriate federal funding for such an investigation the Department of the 13 Interior, Minerals Management Service. The policy of the Commonwealth shall further support the 14 inclusion of the Atlantic Planning Areas in the Minerals Management Service's draft environmental 15 impact statement for further study and analysis and possible lease sales as part of the Department of the 16 Interior's 2007-2012 Five Year Leasing Plan with respect to natural gas exploration 50 miles or more 17 off the Atlantic shoreline. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as a policy statement on the executive 18 or Congressional moratoria on production and development of natural gas off the Atlantic shoreline. It 19 20 shall further be the policy of the Commonwealth to urge the President of the United States to revoke the 21 administrative withdrawal from exploratory and leasing activity of submerged lands that are 50 miles or 22 more off the Atlantic shoreline of the Commonwealth.
