9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. That, in accordance with and as evidence of General Assembly approval pursuant to
11	§§ 10.1-104 and 10.1-109 of the Code of Virginia, the Department of Conservation and Recreation,
12	Lessor, is hereby authorized to lease on behalf of the Commonwealth, upon terms and conditions
13	the Department deems proper, with approval of the Governor and in a form approved by the
14	Attorney General, a portion of First Landing State Park in the City of Virginia Beach to the City
15	of Virginia Beach, Lessee.
16	§ 2. The purpose of the lease is to allow certain property currently owned by the Commonwealth
17	within First Landing State Park, to be used for a recreational facility not operated under the purview of
18	the Department of Conservation and Recreation.
19	§ 3. The lease shall be subject to (i) the public participation guidelines of the Administrative Process
20	Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.) and (ii) inclusion in the master plan for the park.
21	§4. Any further subletting of the property by the Lessee shall be subject to review and approval by
22	the Department, with approval of the Governor and in a form approved by the Attorney General. Upon
23	expiration of the lease, or when the Lessee no longer wishes to have the property operated under the
24	terms of the lease, the Lessee shall return the property to the Department in the condition specified by
25	the lease. [§ 5. The lease agreement shall incorporate language that ensures that the property and any facilities
26	

*constructed on the site provide for adequate public access and use to comply with all requirements of the Land and Water Conservation Act.*] § 6. The provisions of this act shall expire on July 1, [ 2008 2009 ], unless the lease agreement is entered into by the Lessor and Lessee on or before July 1, [ 2008 2009 ]. 27 28 29 30
