10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 2.2-4344 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12 13 14	§ 2.2-4344. Exemptions from competition for certain transactions.
13	A. Any public body may enter into contracts without competition for:
14	1. The purchase of goods or services that are produced or performed by:
15	a. Persons, or in schools or workshops, under the supervision of the Virginia Department for the
16	Blind and Vision Impaired; or
17	b. Nonprofit sheltered workshops or other nonprofit organizations that offer transitional or supported
18	employment services serving the handicapped.
19	2. The purchase of legal services, provided that the pertinent provisions of Chapter 5 (§ 2.2-500 et
20	seq.) of this title remain applicable, or expert witnesses or other services associated with litigation or
21 22	regulatory proceedings.
22	B. An industrial development authority may enter into contracts without competition with respect to
23	any item of cost of "authority facilities" or "facilities" as defined in § 15.2-4902.
24	C. A community development authority formed pursuant to Article 6 (§ 15.2-5152 et seq.) of Chapter
25	51 of Title 15.2, with members selected pursuant to such article, may enter into contracts without
26	competition with respect to the exercise of any of its powers permitted by § 15.2-5158. However, this
27	exception shall not apply in cases where any public funds other than special assessments and
28	incremental real property taxes levied pursuant to § 15.2-5158 are used as payment for such contract.
29	D. The Inspector General for Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services may
30	enter into contracts without competition to obtain the services of licensed health care professionals or
31	other experts to assist in carrying out the duties of the Office of the Inspector General for Mental
32	Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services.

33 E. A local school board may enter into contracts without competition to purchase, from Virginia
34 farmers, food products or commodities grown in Virginia for use in schools.
