SENATE BILL NO. 835

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services  
on January 19, 2007 )

(Patrons Prior to Substitute—Senators Devolites-Davis and Ticer [SB 934])

*A BILL to amend and reenact § 63.2-505.2 of the Code of Virginia, relating to eligibility for TANF and food stamps; drug-related felonies.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 63.2-505.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 63.2-505.2. Eligibility for TANF and food stamps; drug-related felonies.

A person who is otherwise eligible to receive *Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)* or food stamp benefits shall be exempt from the application of section 115(a) of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L. 104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance solely because he has been convicted of a felony offense of possession of a controlled substance in violation of § 18.2-250, provided such person is complying with, or has already complied with, all obligations imposed by the criminal court, is actively engaged in or has completed a substance abuse treatment program, participates in periodic drug screenings, and any other obligations as determined by the Department.
