6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 53.1-33 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 53.1-33. Physical examination of prisoner; ability to work.

9 Each person received by the Department shall be examined by a licensed physician upon his arrival,  
10 *within 30 days prior to any work assignment in food services, medical services, or cosmetological*  
11 *services or a change in work assignment, and at such other times thereafter as may be deemed*  
12 *necessary. The work that a prisoner is required to do shall be dependent upon the report of the physician*  
13 *as to his physical and mental capacity.*

14 *The warden, in consultation with the physician, may exclude prisoners, on a case-by-case basis, from*  
15 *work assignments based upon the classification of the institution and the safety and good order of the*  
16 *institution. Special consideration should be used in assigning any inmate with an infectious disease to*  
17 *assignments in food services, medical services, and cosmetological services.*
