10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 51.1-212 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 51.1-212. Definitions.
13	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
14	"Employee" means any (i) member of the Capitol Police Force as described in § 30-34.2:1, (ii)
15	campus police officer appointed under the provisions of Chapter 17 (§ 23-232 et seq.) of Title 23, (iii)
16	game warden in the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries appointed under the provisions of Chapter
17	2 (§ 29.1-200 et seq.) of Title 29.1, (iv) special agent of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control
18	appointed under the provisions of Chapter 1 (§ 4.1-100 et seq.), (v) law-enforcement officer employed
19	by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission as described in § 9.1-101, (vi) correctional officer as the
20	term is defined in § 53.1-1, and including correctional officers employed at a juvenile correction facility
2 1	as the term is defined in § 66-25.3, (vii) any parole officer appointed pursuant to § 53.1-143, and (viii)
22	any commercial vehicle enforcement officer employed by the Department of State Police, and (ix)
$\overline{23}$	maintenance worker employed by the Department of Corrections whose normal duties require him
24	regularly to be in the presence of inmate populations.
25	"Member" means any person included in the membership of the Retirement System as provided in
2 6	this chapter.
27	"Normal retirement date" means a member's sixtieth birthday.
28	"Retirement System" means the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System.
29	2. That the present value of benefits accrued on behalf of members of the Virginia Retirement
30	System (§ 51.1-124.1 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) who become members of the Virginia Law
31	Officers' Retirement System (§ 51.1-211 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) by virtue of this act shall
32	be transferred from the assets of the Virginia Retirement System to the Virginia Law Officers'
33	Retirement System.
34	3. That any maintenance worker employed by the Department of Corrections who becomes a
35	member of the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of this act
36	and who is in service on June 30, 2007, and July 1, 2007, as such maintenance worker, shall not
37	be subject to the condition under the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System that the person
38	have five or more years of creditable service (i) as a member in the Virginia Law Officers'
39	Retirement System, (ii) as a member in the State Police Officers' Retirement System (§ 51.1-200 et
40	seq. of the Code of Virginia), or (iii) while earning the benefits permitted by § 51.1-138 of the
41	Code of Virginia in order to be eligible to retire under the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement
42	System. However, such maintenance worker must have at least five years of creditable service, as
43	such term is defined in § 51.1-124.3 of the Code of Virginia, and must meet such other applicable
44	conditions under the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System in order to be eligible to retire
45	under such retirement system.
46	4. That any maintenance worker employed by the Department of Corrections who becomes a
47	member of the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of this act
48	shall be eligible only for those retirement benefits under such system that are provided to
49	employees who commence employment or reemployment on or after July 1, 2001.
50	5. That the provisions of this act shall not increase, decrease, or affect in any way the retirement
51	allowance or retirement benefit of any person who retired prior to July 1, 2007, under any
52	retirement system administered by the Virginia Retirement System.
