Community College Scholarship Match Program. § 23-220.5. Community College Scholarship Match Program to provide matching scholarships to students receiving partial tuition scholarships to comprehensive community colleges in Virginia. Funds may be paid to any comprehensive community college on behalf of students who have been awarded such scholarships pursuant to § 23-220.7. § 23-220.6. Community College Scholarship Match Fund. A.
