072490728 1 **SENATE BILL NO. 983** AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE 234567 (Proposed by the Senate Committee on Education and Health on January 25, 2007) (Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Edwards) A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 16 of Title 23 an article numbered 2.1, consisting of sections numbered 23-220.5 through 23-220.7, relating to the Community College 8 Scholarship Match Program. 9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 16 of Title 23 an article numbered 10 11 2.1, consisting of sections numbered 23-220.5 through 23-220.7, as follows: 12 Article 2.1. 13 Community College Scholarship Match Program. 14 § 23-220.5. Community College Scholarship Match Program created. 15 There is hereby created the Community College Scholarship Match Program to provide matching funds to community college foundations and the Virginia Foundation for Community College Education. 16 17 Funds may be paid by the Commonwealth of Virginia to any community college foundation or the Virginia Foundation for Community College Education on the basis of one dollar state general fund 18 appropriation for every one dollar donated by private individuals, foundations, or corporations to a 19 20 community college foundation or the Virginia Foundation for Community College Education. 21 § 23-220.6. Community College Scholarship Match Fund. A. From such funds as are appropriated for this purpose and from such gifts, donations, grants, 22 23 bequests, and other funds as may be received on its behalf, there is hereby created in the state treasury 24 a special nonreverting fund to be known as the Community College Scholarship Match Fund, hereafter 25 referred to as "the Fund." The Fund shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in 26 27 the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of each fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund 28 but shall remain in the Fund. Funds may be paid to any community college foundation or the Virginia 29 Foundation for Community College Education as a one to one match to funds raised by donors, not to 30 exceed an annual state appropriation of five million dollars. 31 Expenditures and disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State Treasurer on warrants 32 issued by the Comptroller upon written request signed by the State Board for Community Colleges. 33 B. The Board shall promulgate regulations for the implementation of the provisions of this article. 34 Community college foundations and the Virginia Foundation for Community College Education shall 35 use any funds received pursuant to this article to award scholarships to eligible students meeting the 36 criteria established in § 23-220.7. 37 § 23-220.7. Eligible students; criteria for award of matching scholarships. 38 A. Only students who (i) are domiciled residents of Virginia as defined by § 23-7.4, (ii) graduated 39 from a public or private Virginia high school, and (iii) are enrolled in a Virginia community college 40 shall be eligible for scholarships pursuant to this article. 41 B. Scholarships awarded pursuant to this article shall be in an amount as determined by the 42 scholarship policy in place at each community college or the scholarship policy of the Virginia

43 Foundation for Community College Education.

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44 *C.* Scholarships awarded pursuant to this article are renewable for one year.

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
