Transportation Trust Fund.<br>The General Assembly shall continue and maintain the Transportation Trust Fund (the Fund), the<br>special nonreverting fund that was established pursuant to Chapter 13 of the Acts of Assembly, 1986<br>Special Session. The General Assembly shall appropriate annually to the Fund an amount at least equal<br>to the revenues generated annually through the additional sales and use taxes, motor vehicle<br>registration fees, motor vehicle sales and use taxes, and motor vehicle fuels taxes imposed and dedicated<br>to the Fund pursuant to Chapters 11, 12, and 15 of the Acts of Assembly, 1986 Special Session, or the   | NTRODUCED SJ317 |

The General Assembly may appropriate additional funds to the<br>Transportation Trust Fund. Money in the Fund may be invested as authorized by law. The General<br>Assembly may enact a reduction in the sales and use taxes that affects sales and use taxes generally;<br>however, the reduction shall not reduce the amount of revenues payable to the Fund under the 1986<br>appropriation of additional sales and use taxes payable to the Fund.<br>The General Assembly shall appropriate the proceeds of the Fund only for purposes of constructing,<br>improving, operating, administering, and maintaining the roads embraced in the systems of state<br>highways for the Commonwealth and its localities and furthering the interests of the Commonwealth in<br>the areas of public transportation, railways, seaports, and airports.<br>The General Assembly may borrow an amount from the Fund for other purposes only by a vote<br>equal to or greater than three-fifths of the members voting and how he voted shall be recorded in<br>the journal of the house. Any amount borrowed shall be repaid to the Fund from general funds not later<br>than four years after the date on which the loan was made. Any legislative action by the General<br>Assembly that results in a reduction in the annual appropriation to the Fund from the minimum<br>appropriation required by this section shall constitute borrowing from the Fund and shall be subject to<br>the requirements of this section for repayment and for a recorded vote equal to or greater than<br>three-fifths of the members voting in each house, including a majority of the members elected to that<br>house.<br>The General Assembly shall enact such laws as may be necessary to maintain the Fund and<br>implement the provisions of this section. |                 |
