WHEREAS, Ron Brown served twice as the president of United Steel Workers Local No. 8-675 PACE Union of Covington and in 2004 was inducted into its PACE Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, concerned with the well-being of his fellow citizens, Ron Brown was a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose No. 610 and active in the organization's many charitable activities in the community; and

WHEREAS, Ron Brown will be fondly remembered for his sense of duty and loyalty and greatly missed by his wife, Lois Bryan Brown of Valley Ridge, his four brothers and their families, his numerous other family members and friends, and the citizens of Covington and Clifton Forge; now, therefore, be it
