 since 1916, members have gathered in a building purchased by the lodge on the corner of Nelson and
 Jefferson streets in historic downtown Lexington; and

events planned during the year, with a grand celebration to take place on September 29, 2007, that will
be attended by the current Grand Master of Virginia and his Grand Line Officers as well as past Grand
Masters; and

WHEREAS, Mountain City Lodge No. 67 is an important part of the Lexington community,
supporting numerous charities and organizations including the Boy Scouts, Rockbridge Area Free Clinic,
Rockbridge Area Relief Association, Yellow Brick Road Early Learning Center, Rockbridge Area
Hospice, Salvation Army, and the Lexington Fire Department and sponsoring two scholarships for local
