### SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 48

Offered February 16, 2007

*Amending and readopting Rule 51 of the Rules of the Senate, relating to the Senate Ethics Advisory Panel; certain prohibitions; lobbying.*

RESOLVED by the Senate, That Rule 51 of the Rules of the Senate is amended and readopted as follows:

#### XVII.

Senate Ethics Advisory Panel; *certain prohibitions; lobbying.*

51 (a). The Senate Ethics Advisory Panel shall be composed of five members: three of whom shall be former members of the Senate; and two of whom shall be citizens of the Commonwealth who have not previously held such office. The members shall be nominated by the Committee on Privileges and Elections Rules of the Senate and confirmed by the Senate. Nominations shall be made so as to assure bipartisan representation on the Panel.

51 (b). No member of the Senate shall engage in any activities that would require registration as a lobbyist under § 2.2-422 of the Code of Virginia or be a member of a law firm where any members engage in any activities that would require registration as a lobbyist under § 2.2-422.
