**4. Title** Speed limits on certain lakes.

**5. Summary/Purpose:**

Establishes a maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour on Smith Mountain Lake between sunset and sunrise. Anyone who exceeds this limit is subject to a fine of up to \$250.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are:** Preliminary. See item 8, below.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal implications:** The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries will need to assign four wardens to the night patrols. These patrols would run from sunset to sun rise and consist of two six hour patrols each day. The Department will assign one boat and two wardens to each patrol.

To implement the provisions of the bill the agency can redeploy existing staff.

Any revenue collected in the enforcement of this bill will be deposited to the state's Literary Fund.
