**4. Title** Driver improvement clinics; use of fees.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** Driver improvement clinic fees. Provides that neither the annual license fees for additional clinic locations nor the annual license fees for clinic instructor licenses will be required of or collected from the Virginia Association of Volunteer Rescue Squads or its members in connection with clinics that are provided for emergency vehicle operation training.

**6. No Fiscal Impact**

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** This bill presents neither a systems nor an operations impact to DMV. There is no revenue loss since these programs are not currently certified, and thus no fees are collected. One Emergency Vehicle Operator Clinics (EVOC) primary location would pay an annual \$100 certification fee.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** DMV

**11. Other comments:** The Virginia Code already provides an exemption to members of volunteer rescue squads and volunteer fire departments for the \$10 processing fee associated with participating in a driver improvement clinic pursuant to § 46.2-502.
