4. Title School bus safety hotline; Board of Education to establish.

5. Summary/Purpose: Permits local school boards to display decals relating to local school division bus safety hotlines, notwithstanding any regulation to the contrary. Local school divisions shall be responsible for the cost of the decals bearing the number of such safety hotline. Such decal shall not obstruct the name of the school division or the number of the school bus.

8. Fiscal implications: This legislation clearly states that school divisions shall be responsible for any costs associated with such decals so there will be no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.
