- **5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill eliminates the fee to receive driving record abstracts from the Department of Motor Vehicles for (i) local government group self-insurance pools, (ii) law-enforcement officers, (iii) attorneys and court officials for the Commonwealth, (iv) officials of counties, cities, and towns, and (v) court, police, and licensing officials of other states and of the federal government.

- 8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) has processed 6,589 halfprice transcripts for governmental entities and collected \$19,767 in total revenue since the effective date of House Bill 646 on July 1, 2006. This six month total would project to be an estimated 13,178 transcripts and \$39,534 in total revenue on an annual basis. These statistics do not include local government group self-insurance pools, since the legislation would add them to the list of entities that may obtain transcripts free of charge. The number of local government group self-insurance pools that would request a transcript from DMV is not known.
