4. Title Overtaking and passing vehicles on certain highways; prohibits travel in left-most lane of highway.

5. Summary/Purpose: Prohibits travel in the left-most lane of any limited access highway except to pass another vehicle traveling in the same direction. The bill also directs the Department of State Police to prepare and implement a public awareness initiative for the purpose of educating the public of the prohibition.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: PRELIMINARY; See Item 8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: Yes, Item 415.

8. Fiscal implications: According to the Department of State Police, additional resources will be needed to implement a public awareness initiative in order to educate the public of the provisions of this proposal. The department estimates needing \$80,000 for public service announcements, public signage, media contract and development of media messages.
