4. Title: State Comptroller; reporting other obligations of State, report

5. Summary/Purpose: Directs the State Comptroller, in conjunction with the Secretary of Finance, to report biannually to the Governor and the General Assembly each off-balance sheet financial obligation of the Commonwealth, itemized by agency, board, institution, or authority of the Commonwealth, as well as any other obligations of the Commonwealth that are estimated by the State Comptroller to be incurred.

8. Fiscal implications: According to the Department of Accounts, there will be additional financial reporting work for Accounts and agencies. Also there may be additional actuarial costs if other unfunded liabilities are identified in order to put a value on the obligations.
