**4. Title** Virginia Disability Commission Sunset; repeal

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill changes the sunset provision for the Virginia Disability Commission from July 1, 2007, to July 1, 2012. This bill is a recommendation of the Disability Commission.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are:** See Item 8.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No

**8. Fiscal implications:** This legislation would repeal the sunset of July 1, 2007, for the Virginia Disability Commission. The legislation proposes that the Commission sunset July 1, 2012. Currently, the Commission is budgeted at \$25,000 per year for operating expenses in the Division of Legislative Services, Item 6. Extending the sunset would not create any additional fiscal impact but would eliminate \$25,000 in savings beginning in FY 2009. (Funding for the Commission is included in the 2006 Appropriation Act for both years of the biennium.) After July 1, 2012 savings of \$25,000 could be realized.
