4. Title: Prohibition on construction of private wells

5. Summary/Purpose: Prohibits the construction of private wells within 50 feet of the property line adjacent to agricultural property unless the owner of the adjacent property grants written permission for construction within 50 feet of the property line; or receives certification that no other site on the property complies with the Board's regulations for the construction of a private well. The Department is required, before issuing a permit, to obtain written affirmation from the applicant that the well construction site is in compliance. The Department shall accept private site evaluations and designs, in compliance with the Board's regulations for the construction of private wells, designed and certified by a licensed professional engineer, in consultation with an authorized onsite soil evaluator, or by an authorized onsite soil evaluator.
