3. Committee Passed Both Houses

4. Title Elections; voter registration records; authorize matching with lists of other states.

5. Summary/Purpose: Authorizes State Board of Elections (SBE) to sell voter lists to other states with protections for privacy of voter social security numbers. Authorizes cancellation of voter registration based on information from registration officials of other states. Makes conforming changes to sections referring to social security numbers to prohibit disclosure of parts of numbers. Requires SBE to monitor implementation of this act and provide annual reports to the General Assembly starting July 1, 2008

7. Budget amendment necessary: No

8. Fiscal implications: SBE indicates that the impact of this bill would be negligible. SBE anticipates practicing reciprocity with other states with neither state charging the other for a list. Reporting and monitoring can be absorbed within SBE current appropriations.
