4. Title Hunting on Sundays.

5. Summary/Purpose: Allows landowners to hunt on their own property on Sundays. Also allows persons who have the written permission of the landowner to hunt on the landowner's property on Sundays.

6. No fiscal impact. See item 8, below.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The provisions of the bill could result in additional calls requiring the services of a game warden. However, the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries does not anticipate that the legislation will have a fiscal impact.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Game and Inland Fisheries.

10. Technical amendment necessary: No.

11. Other comments: HB 1639 also provides for hunting on Sunday. It would permit hunting from noon to one-half hour after sunset.
