4. Title Model firearms hunting ordinances.

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill requires the Board of Game and Inland Fisheries to develop, through regulations, model ordinances for hunting with firearms that may be adopted by counties or cities. The ordinances developed by the Board are to address such items as the caliber of the firearm, the type of firearm, and the type of ammunition.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final. See item 8, below.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries will incur some costs in developing regulations establishing model ordinances for hunting and firearms for adoption by localities. However, any impact is expected to be minimal and can be absorbed within existing resources.
