4. Title Child labor; certain employment prohibited; farm wineries.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill allows a child under the age of 18 years to work at a licensed Virginia farm winery provided the child does not serve or dispense in any manner alcoholic beverages.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Labor and Industry (DOLI) anticipates that this bill will have only a minimal impact on their agency. They will be required to handle phone calls as a result of the new provision, but anticipate that current staff should be able to handle any additional work load. DOLI estimates a cost of \$684.00 for the Web posting to communicate this new regulation, but can absorb these costs.
