5. Summary/Purpose: Health insurance credits; teachers. Increases the monthly health insurance credit to retired teachers from \$2.50 to \$4 for each full year of the retired member's

creditable service and removes the \$75 a month cap. Deletes the local option for an additional \$1 for the health insurance credit and uses the traditional VRS disability formula

to calculate the health insurance credit for those who retire on disability.

The effective date of the provisions of the bill is July 1, 2007 and is applicable to teachers who retired prior to the effective date of this legislation and to those who will retire on or after July 1, 2007.
