**5. Summary/Purpose:** Requires that all Medical Examiner's reports shall be confidential and not available for discovery except as provided. The Chief Medical Examiner shall release the autopsy report concerning a prisoner committed to any local correctional facility to the local sheriff or superintendent. The bill also allows the Chief Medical Examiner to release the autopsy report to the decedent's attending physician and to the personal representative or executor of the decedent. If no personal representative or executor is appointed, then the autopsy report can be released at the discretion of the Chief Medical Examiner.
