5. Summary/Purpose: Makes it a Class 4 misdemeanor for hunters retrieving their hunting dogs from prohibited lands to willfully refuse to identify themselves when requested by the landowner or landowner's agent.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final. See item 8, below.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The penalty for a Class 4 misdemeanor is a fine of not more than \$250. Any revenue will be deposited to the state's Literary Fund.
