- **3. Committee** Education
- **4. Title** Standards of Quality; Standard 2; pupil-teacher ratios.
- **5. Summary/Purpose:** Reduces the current pupil-teacher ratio in kindergarten from an average daily membership of 24:1 to 21:1 and in grades one, two, and three from 24:1 to 20:1. This bill also provides that the pupil-teacher ratio may not exceed 25:1 in average daily membership in grades four through six, and 24:1 in average daily membership in English in grades six through 12.
- 6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: See Item 8.
- 7. Budget amendment necessary: Yes, Item 135.
- 8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Education estimates that this legislation will result in an additional general fund cost of \$83.7 million in FY 2008. This estimate is based on the impact of the proposed changes to pupil-teacher ratios in the Standards of Quality and assumes that the legislation would not be effective until July 1, 2007.
