4. Title: Brain and spinal cord injury registry.

5. Summary/Purpose: Brain and spinal cord injury registry. Specifies that the registry shall include all brain and spinal cord injuries, regardless of severity, and updates the language relating to research on human subjects to be consistent with state and federal law. The bill also exempts physicians from the reporting requirement, and changes the timeline for reporting to within 30 days of identification for spinal cord injuries, to be consistent with the requirement for brain injuries.
