4. Title Exempts certain career and technology projects; Board of Contractors

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill adds work undertaken by students as part of a career and technical education project for the construction of portable classrooms or single family homes, to the list of exemptions from the contractor licensing requirements.

8. Fiscal implications: The Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) reports that this bill will have no fiscal impact on them.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.

Other comments: DPOR clarifies that although the projects constructed by students will be exempt from contractor licensing requirements, there will still be afforded a level of protection by the local building official who inspects these structures for compliance with the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code.
