**4. Title** Freedom of Information Act; posting of meeting notices and minutes.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill clarifies where meeting notices and minutes of state public bodies must be posted. The bill also specifies that only notices of public hearings on proposed regulations need be published in the Virginia Register. The bill is a recommendation of the Virginia Code Commission. The House amendments simply clarifies that the Registrar is to publish every two weeks a Virginia Register of Regulations that is to include notices of all public hearings on regulations.

**8. Fiscal implications:** This bill provides a technical adjustment to clarify the current practice that state agencies must post their meetings on their website and the Commonwealth Calendar. It also specifies requirements for the Virginia Registrar.
