**5. Summary/Purpose:**

This bill directs the Virginia Department of Transportation to repair the Haley's Mill Pond Dam and a portion of Virginia Route 629 in Middlesex County.

**8. Fiscal implications:** If VDOT sustains the costs to replace this dam and spillway, the funds would be drawn from the County's six-year plan construction funds, the total of which is unknown at this time.
