Retail Franchising Act.

5. Summary/Purpose: Retail Franchising Act. Authorizes the State Corporation Commission to require, as a condition of franchise registration, that the franchise fees and other funds paid by a franchisee to the franchisor be escrowed or deferred until the franchisor's preopening obligations are fulfilled, if the liabilities of the franchisor or any controlling person exceed its assets. The measure also authorizes the State Corporation Commission to exempt franchises from registration by rule or order.

- **8. Fiscal implications**: The Division of Securities and Retail Franchising anticipates increased application activity resulting in increased staff review time. As a result the Division will need to hire two additional staff members (base salaries plus benefits, \$116,330) and secure office space and computers (\$8,872). We expect revenues to increase more in the first fiscal year after implementation than in subsequent years. Applicants will file a nonrecurring application fee in the first year.
