4. Title: VDOT biennial report on maintaining and operating existing transportation infrastructure

5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill creates a new reporting requirement for VDOT. This bill requires VDOT to report by September 15 of each odd-numbered year on condition of and needs for maintaining and operating the existing transportation infrastructure based on an asset management methodology. Methodology shall identify and prioritize maintenance and operations needs. Report shall include the performance standards to be used to determine the needs and estimate the budget required in the upcoming two fiscal years to meet them.

8. Fiscal implications: The cost to acquire data needed to develop performance standards and to determine the needs to meet the standards for some operations, such as congestion reduction, is not known at this time. Additional manpower needed would depend on how the data are to be collected and who will perform the analyses.
