4. Title: VDOT biennial report on maintaining and operating existing transportation infrastructure

5. Summary/Purpose:

This bill requires VDOT to submit a biennial report on the condition and needs for maintaining and operating the existing transportation infrastructure based on an asset management methodology. Report shall include the performance standards used to determine the needs, an estimate of the budget required in the upcoming two fiscal years to meet the needs, employment level goals for the upcoming two years, and the percentage of asset management under private contract.

Fiscal implications:** The cost to acquire data needed to develop performance standards and to determine the needs to meet the standards for some operations, such as congestion reduction, is not known at this time.
