4. Title Student information; public schools, public institutions of higher education.

5. Summary/Purpose: Authorizes public schools and public institutions of higher education in Virginia to retain certified copies of enrolled students' birth certificates as part of the students' records.

6. No Fiscal Impact.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: Currently, any person enrolling a student in any public school in Virginia is required to present a certified copy of the student's birth record. The official state birth number printed on the birth record is recorded in the student's permanent school record. This legislation would allow the school division to also retain a copy of the student's birth record. It is anticipated that any administrative costs associated with this legislation would be negligible and absorbed within current resources.
