**5. Summary/Purpose:** The proposed legislation would grant the Portsmouth Port and Industrial Commission (the Commission) the authority to provide financing by leasing, selling, or making loans for facilities for a 501(c)(3) organization.

**8. Fiscal implications:** The proposed legislation would authorize the Commission to provide financing to certain organizations. The funds provided to the organizations cannot have already been pledged or assigned for the payment of any of the Commissions other bonds or notes. The debt issued for the benefit of the organization is to be payable only from the revenues derived from the leasing or sale of facilities owned by the Commission. The Commission is authorized to charge an administrative fee for issuing the debt.
