- **5. Summary/Purpose:** Provides that the maximum speed limit will be 60 miles per hour where indicated by lawfully placed signs, erected subsequent to a traffic engineering study and analysis of accident and law-enforcement data, on U.S. Route 29, U.S. Route 58, U.S. Route 360, U.S. Route 460, and on U.S. Route 17 between Port Royal and Saluda where there are non-limited access, multilane, divided highways. There is also a second enactment that the provisions of this act shall not be applicable to posted speed limits in effect prior to July 1, 2007.
- 6. No Fiscal Impact.
- 7. Budget amendment necessary: No.
- **8. Fiscal implications:** The Department of State Police does not expect a fiscal impact due to the proposed legislation.
