4. Title Health professions; authority to send laboratory test results directly to patients

5. Summary/Purpose: Requires any licensed health care practitioner who orders a laboratory test or other examination of the physical or mental condition of any person to, if so requested by the patient or his legal guardian, inform the laboratory or other facility conducting the test or examination to provide a copy of the report of the results directly to the patient or his legal guardian. The patient shall then be considered authorized to receive the report or result for the purposes of the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments.
