4. Title Recovery of third part liability payments

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill conforms state law to the federal Deficit Reduction Act of 2005. Specifically, it deals with the enhancement of third party identification and payment by Medicaid programs. The bill expands the definition of insurer and clarifies the right of recovery against any third party legally responsible for a payment of a claim for health care. In addition, it requires the third party provide the state with coverage and eligibility information and to accept claims submitted by the state Medicaid agency for reimbursement.
