4. Title Virginia Fort Monroe Reuse Authority

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill creates the Virginia Fort Monroe Reuse Authority (the Authority), provides for its membership, and sets its quorum. The Authority is to recommend to the Governor and the General Assembly a reuse plan pertaining to Fort Monroe, specifically as to the entity that should own and operate all of Fort Monroe, including any right of the Commonwealth to receive such property in the event of a reversion. In creating the reuse plan, the Authority is to fully consider the most appropriate use of the Fort Monroe lands. The bill also states that it is the Commonwealth's desire that the Virginia Congressional delegation seek authorization for a National Park Service study for the potential inclusion of Fort Monroe in the National Park System.

8. Fiscal implications: To the extent that the members of the Authority incur travel expenses and per diems, there may be costs.
