3. Committee Passed Both Houses

4. Title Disbursement of funds appropriated for caring for Revolutionary War cemeteries and graves.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill provides that the number of grave sites located at New Providence Presbyterian Church that are eligible for funding under § 10.1-2211.1 of the Code be increased one, from 15 to 16.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are: Final.

7. Budget amendment necessary: See Item 8.

8. Fiscal implications: Historically, the General Assembly has always provided funding for the responsibilities set-out in this bill. However, the budget passed by the General Assembly did not provide the \$5.00 but inserted the following language: "Out of the appropriations for this Item, the Department shall reimburse the Virginia Society of the Sons of the American Revolution for one additional grave site in New Providence Presbyterian Church in Rockbridge County."

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: The Department of Historic Resources

10. Technical amendment necessary: No.

11. Other comments: The Code currently specifies that the "allocation of appropriations for the maintenance of Revolutionary War cemeteries shall be based on the number of graves, monuments and markers as set forth opposite the cemetery name, or as documented by each association multiplied by the rate of five dollars or the average actual cost of routine maintenance, whichever is greater, for each grave, monument, or marker in the care of a cemetery association," (§10.1-2211.1 B.).
